Delivering Gymnastics Safely at Key Stage 1 and 2

This course will equip you with the necessary skills, knowledge and understanding to safely deliver Gymnastics as part of your school's Physical Education curriculum. Throughout the day you will observe a practical teaching session delivered by the course tutor using pupils from the host school and be introduced to effective organisational principles. You will practise supporting (ie 'hands on') pupils as they perform the progressive steps of learning forward and backward rolls and other gymnastic skills. Later in the day you will explore the effective use and positioning of apparatus and mats, transition of floor skills onto apparatus, together with key health and safety issues.

*Delegates will need to provide their own packed lunch, although refreshments will be available throughout the day. Delegates will need to come suitably dressed for practical activity.
